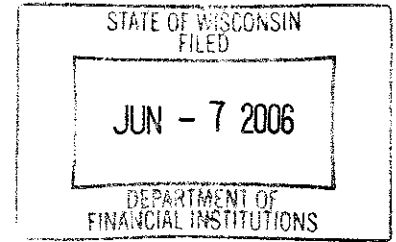

Title of Document

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I, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a non-stock, non-profit corporation, in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin, acknowledge and file these Articles of Incorporation in the office of the Department of Financial Institutions of the State of Wisconsin.



ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Prairie Park at Swan Creek Unit Owners Association, Inc. ("**Association**").

ARTICLE II
PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purpose for which the Association is formed is to operate as an association, as that term is defined in Chapter 703, Wisconsin Statutes, for Prairie Park at Swan Creek Condominium ("**Condominium**").

To accomplish the foregoing purpose, the Association shall have all common law and statutory corporate powers under Chapters 181 and 703, Wisconsin Statutes, including, without enumeration, all such powers which may be exercised by an association as if specifically granted in its articles of incorporation. In addition, the Association is authorized to qualify for tax-exempt status under Section 528, Internal Revenue Code of 1986, to merge with other associations, and to delegate powers to a master association, as that term is defined in Chapter 703, Wisconsin Statutes.

ARTICLE III
MEMBERS

Section 1. Each Unit Owner in the Condominium ("**Member**") shall automatically be a member of the Association and his, her, its or their membership in the Association shall automatically terminate when the Member sells the Member's Unit. If a Member sells the Member's Unit, the purchaser of the Member's Unit will automatically acquire membership in the Association under the provisions of the Declaration. Membership certificates are not required and will not be issued. The rights and obligations of membership shall be as set forth in the Association's By-Laws and applicable law.

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Section 2. The share of a Member in the funds and assets of the Association cannot be assigned, hypothecated or transferred in any manner except as an appurtenance to the Member's Unit.

ARTICLE IV
EXISTENCE

The Association shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI
DIRECTORS

The affairs and property of the Association shall be managed and governed by a Board of Directors composed of not less than three (3) persons. The number of directors will be determined from time to time pursuant to the Association's By-Laws.

ARTICLE VII
BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The following persons shall constitute the initial Board of Directors and shall hold office and serve until their successors are elected as provided in the Association's By-Laws.

The registered agent of the Association is John Sveum and the registered office of the Association is 1249 Williamson Street, Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, 53703.


ARTICLE X
AMENDMENTS

An affirmative vote of sixty-seven (67%) percent of all votes entitled to be cast by Members shall be required for approval of an amendment of these Articles.

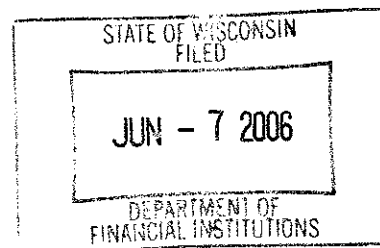
ARTICLE XI
INDEMNIFICATION

Every director and officer of the Association shall be indemnified by the Association against all expenses and liabilities, including attorneys' fees reasonably incurred by or imposed upon such director or officer in connection with any proceedings or any settlement thereof, to which such director or officer may be a party, or in which such director or officer may become involved by reason of such director or officer being or having been a director or officer of the Association, whether or not such director or officer is a director or officer at the time such expenses are incurred, except in such cases wherein the director or officer is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance in the performance of such director's or officer's duties; provided that in the event of a settlement, the indemnification herein shall apply only when the Board of Directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being in the best interests of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such director or officers may be entitled.


